

2. 




the in depth knowledge about opening of demat account and trading account. and Mutual Funds. The session was ended by throwing the light on KYC to be done before Investing.



Annual Report B.A.M.M.C. Department 2022-23

The **Bachelor of Arts in Multimedia and Mass Communication (BAMMC)** of our college headed by coordinator **Asst. Prof. Manimekhalai Iyer**, brings about a different flavour to already existing departments. The three-year Bachelor of Mass Media programme is affiliated to the University of Mumbai. It is a full-time degree programme divided into six semesters. The course enables an in-depth understanding of the dynamic field of mass media in its various forms – print, radio, television, advertising, PR, new media and films. In the third year, students select any one of the specialisations from Advertising and Journalism.

This department for all practicality has a unique characteristic of enormous all-round growth of a student. It provides practical and theoretical knowledge to the aspiring media professional students. It also creates new opportunities via our career counselling sessions and placement opportunities. Under the guidance of the faculties of the department, our students participated in various seminars/competitions organized by our college & other colleges and organizations. Our students were motivated to join SWAYAM courses for additional knowledge. PTM was conducted so as to keep in touch with the parents and keep them updated about the development of their ward.

This department received a new syllabus in the year 2019-2020 and it faced covid lockdown at the same time. Notwithstanding this fact, the department was able to hold a number of activities through the last three years. The teaching methodology used by our field-expert faculty are lectures, sessions with industry experts, and workshops, and the department lays special emphasis on field-based projects. - 16. Lastly, our department was able to register all our students to Swayam Courses as an add-on to their syllabus.



NAME OF THE ACTIVITY: NextFuture In I.T





National Service Scheme popularly known as NSS, was started to establish a meaningful linkage between the campus and the community. Mahatma Gandhi, the Father of the Nation, had recognized that the country could not progress in a desired direction until the student youth were motivated to work for the upliftment of the villages/community. The National Service Scheme was launched in Gandhi Centenary Year, 1969 and aimed at developing student's personality through community service.

The NSS Unit of our college has 100 volunteers for the current academic year and serves the community under the guidance of Asst. Prof. Sampada Mavalankar, NSS Programme Officer and Asst. Prof. Ruta Bhosale, NSS Committee Member.

As per the discussion with advisory committee around 86 regular activities with 7 days special residential camp were planned and executed effectively in the current academic year. After two years of Covid-19 pandemic situation, the NSS volunteers served the community in true sense and participated at different levels.

Under the theme of Environment & Enrichment, activities such as Plastic Waste Awareness Rally, 8 Plastic Waste Collection Drives, Plastic Waste Management Session by Mrs. Rashmi Joshi, Environment Consultant, Eco-Bricks Making etc were conducted in the vicinity area to create an awareness regarding the plastic waste and its ill effects on the environment. The volunteers extended a support for the Entrepreneurship Skills of Tribal Women of Seva Vivek NGO, Palghar District by selling around 650 Eco-Friendly & Sustainable Bamboo Rakhis and 60 different bamboo products.

The objective of the project was


- To develop the sense of responsibility among students towards society.
