The institute's regular lights have been replaced with LED bulbs up to the third floor through a floor-by-floor exchange initiative. Furthermore, extra measures are taken to switch off any and every light or fan that is not in use at the moment.
- **Management of the Various Types of Degradable and Non-Degradable Waste:**
 - A) **Degradable waste is disposed** of through various means. Biodegradable waste such as food, garden, and paper waste are effectively disposed of through various means.

Vermicomposting is used to discard raw food material and plant waste. The composts produced in this green process are used as a natural fertiliser for enhancing plant growth on the college campus. On the other hand, plate waste i.e. organic waste with higher starch contents is disposed of in the bacterial compost pit.

B) Recycling measures are implemented in order to manage non-degradable waste. Plastic waste is collected by the workforce and NSS volunteers of the college and is recycled with Therco Company & Rotary Club. E-waste is either donated if useful or handed over to Therco Company for recycling. The common municipal drain is used to discharge the effluent water. There is no hazardous or chemical waste generated in the college.

- **Water conservation:**

A) The institute has implemented well-designed and structured means to conserve water in various forms. Rainwater harvesting is employed on the campus in order to reserve water. A built-in catchment area is installed to collect large volumes of water. Additionally, our college has two borewells installed and an underground tank for water conservation.

B) Fix leaks: Leaks are a common source of wasted water, and our institution is saving significant amounts of water by promptly fixing leaks in buildings, irrigation systems, and other campus infrastructure.

C) Promote behavioural changes: Our institution is promoting behavioural changes among students and staff to reduce water usage.

- **Green campus initiatives:**

A) To foster a culture of environmental consciousness and sustainability: Our institute has maintained an eco-friendly campus through various means. The campus is surrounded by an abundance of flora, including a Butterfly Garden and a portion for medicinal plants. A variety of seasonal fruits, vegetables, and other plants have been produced on the campus.

B) A restriction on the use of plastic and a ban on single-use plastics have been implemented. Students' vehicles are not permitted entry into the campus to prevent pollution. Also, the movement of student vehicles is prohibited.

Roles and Responsibilities of Ms. Rashmi Joshi:

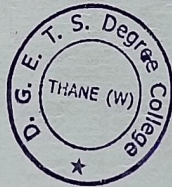
1. Conduct awareness sessions as well as activities amongst youth and students about the use of waste as well as water as a resource and its relationship with climate change and global warming.

2. Encourage and promote environment-related activities such as Composting, E-waste Collection, Seedballs, and Rainwater Harvesting.
3. Sensitize and involve students from the college/institute for promoting the concept of environment-related projects.
4. I will conduct periodic supervision of once in a week in the first month & then once in a fortnight for a period of three months from the initiation of composting project.

E- WASTE MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement, entered into on 22nd April, 2022 as the "Effective Date" by and between Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science having office Opp. Unnathi Greens, Near Haware Citi, Kasarvadavali, G.B.Road, Thane (W)- 400615 and Threco Recycling LLP, having its office at D-402 Remi Bizcourt, Shah Industrial Estate, Off Veera Desai Road, Andheri West, Mumbai 400053, here in after called "Threco".

Whereas Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science has identified E-waste and paper waste (E-waste as per E-waste Management Rules, 2018) that it may from time to time wish to recycle, and Threco desires to execute a complete waste management program on behalf of Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science to process the E-waste and paper waste.

THEREFORE, Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science shall provide, and Threco shall recycle the Material in accordance with the following terms of this Agreement:

1. Material:

Material is hereinafter defined as E-waste and paper waste (E-waste as per E-waste Management Rules, 2018). Material specifically excludes equipment containing radioactive materials, free flowing liquids, chlorofluorocarbons, polychlorinated biphenyls, or other "Hazardous Wastes". Threco reserves the right to deny pick up of any E-waste as it may deem fit. Threco will also collect paper waste from the Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science.

2. Services:

2.1 . Threco will ensure the E-waste and paper waste picked up by Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science is disposed in a compliant manner.

2.2 . Disposal Certificate, for the applicable material, will be provided to Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science within 3 weeks from the date of receipt of material at the facility.

2.3. Cost of transportation will be borne by Threco.

3. Payment/Charges

3.1 Threco will dispose and pick up the E-waste and pay Rs.12 (inclusive of all taxes) per kg of E-waste (excluding batteries, cartridges and toners, tube lights, bulbs) to Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science.

3.2 If the quantity of E-waste collected is 500kg or more for a single pick-up the amount payable would be Rs.15 (inclusive of all taxes) per kg.

3.3. Batteries, Toners, Cartridges, Tubelights and Bulbs are negative items and Threco shall not pay anything for these items but will ensure that they are disposed in the most eco- friendly manner.

3.4 Threco will be glad to conduct an online/ offline awareness/ training program on E-waste at a nominal charge of Rs.1500 per session.

3.5 Threco would collect paper waste and pay Rs.5 (inclusive of all taxes) to Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science.

4. Threco Representation and Warranties:

4.1 In the performance of all Services to be provided hereunder, Threco agrees to comply with all applicable permits, all central, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances and all duly constituted authorities.

4.2 Threco will be responsible for the statutory compliances including environmental compliances pertaining to the scrap disposal activities and Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science will not in any way be responsible for the same once the scrap material is handed over by Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science to Threco.

5 Representations and Warranties:

5.1 Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science agrees that it has free and unencumbered title to all Material delivered to Threco pursuant of this Agreement.

5.2 Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science shall issue all proper despatch documents, where applicable.

6 Terms:

This agreement shall have a term of Two (2) years from the Effective Date. Threco will be the official/ exclusive E-waste collector and recycler for the institution.

7. Independent Contractor:

In furnishing Services pursuant to this Agreement, either Party will at all times be acting as an independent contractor and this Agreement will not be construed to create any association,

partnership, joint venture, relation of principal and agent or employer and employee between one Party and the other Party or its agents.

8. Miscellaneous:

8.1 All services performed by Threco for Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science while this Agreement is in effect shall be subject to its provisions unless otherwise agreed in writing before the performance of such services is started.

8.2 This Agreement may be terminated at any time by Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science or Threco, upon material breach by either party or upon 30 days written notice to the other party without any reason.

8.3 If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, then it shall be considered severable (only to the extent necessary) and the remaining provisions will not be impaired and this Agreement will be interpreted as far as possible to give effect to its stated purpose.

8.4 This Agreement constitutes and fully expresses the entire and only agreement between the parties with the respect to the subject matter thereof; all prior and collateral understandings, agreements and promises with respect thereto are considered merged herein. This Agreement may not be modified, waived, or extended unless mutually agreed to in writing, and it may not be terminated except as provided above. A waiver by either party of any terms and conditions of this Agreement in one or more instances will not constitute a permanent waiver of such terms and conditions unless so stated in writing.

8.5 The laws of India will govern the validity, interpretation, construction, performance and enforcement of this agreement. Both the parties mutually agree that the Courts in Mumbai, Maharashtra shall have the sole and exclusive jurisdiction, with regards to the present Agreement and the rights and obligations contained herein, in exclusion of all other courts.

9. Confidentiality

The agreement protects the information provided to Threco by Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science from further disclosure or misuse. The information shall not to be disclosed to persons other than Threco's personnel having a reasonable need for access to serve Dnyan Ganga Education Trust's Degree College of Arts, Commerce & Science. The provisions of this clause shall apply mutatis mutandis to the other party.

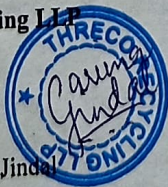

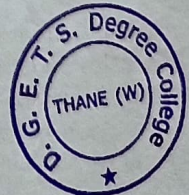
